Pictures: Acrylics, oils, water-colours, gouache, pencil, charcoal, pastels, pen and wash, collage and all comparable media are acceptable, including monoprints & limited edition giclee prints, unique computer generated and photographic images.

SELECTION and SIZES:

All works will be subject to selection by a committee on the basis of artistic merit . **FRAMING:**

All pictures, unless a canvas edge return, must be properly framed with any glass edges covered. All work must have hanging D-rings and strong hanging cord or picture wire.

All works must be labelled at the back of pictures, on the base of sculptures or its plinth. The labelling to show:
